# John Durand Scholarship Program

# Scholarship Funds Available for 2025-2026 Academic Year

Do you know a student who could use \$500 for school expenses? The John Durand Scholarship Program can help. Any student admitted to or attending an accredited post-secondary academic program in the United States and Canada is eligible to apply. Membership in the Durand Heritage Foundation (DHF) is not required.

For twenty-one years, the DHF newsletter has chronicled the story of these annual scholarship awards - 87 scholarships to date, totaling nearly \$40,000 - and the letters of appreciation from the students who received them. Thanks to the generosity of loyal DHF donors across the country, the John Durand Scholarship Program will continue its positive impact on the DHF family and the community-at-large. Please encourage the students in your family or community to apply.

## About the John Durand Scholarship Program

#### Purpose

The John Durand Scholarship Program provides scholarship awards in two areas.

- 1) <u>Academic Scholarship</u>: financial assistance to students in or admitted to accredited academic programs.
- 2) <u>Durand Family Research</u>: financial assistance to individuals who research and write about Durand family history or events significant to Durand family history.

# Program Background

The John Durand Scholarship Program was originally established in 2002 with memorial gifts and donations received by the family of John Adelard Durand after his untimely death at age 37.

John Clifford Durand (John Adelard Durand's father) died in 2020. This scholarship honors them both.

Each year the scholarship program makes five Scholarship Awards. Because of DHF's continued fundraising, cash donations, gifts, and bequests, the scholarship awards are now \$500 each unless otherwise determined by the DHF board.

Research Awards are available as funds permit and may be made at any time.

#### Administration

The John Durand Scholarship Program funds are managed in accounts separate from DHF operating funds. A committee manages the application process; evaluates the applications, and nominates the awardees to the DHF board which has final approval of the awards.

#### Eligibility

Awards are made without regard to race, color, religion (creed), gender, gender expression, sexual orientation national origin (ancestry), disability, marital status, military status or relationship to the Durand family. All applicants currently enrolled in or accepted into a post-secondary course of study in an accredited educational program in the United States and Canada are eligible. Preference is given to first time applicants but former awardees or applicants may also apply. The evaluation criteria is based on academic record, community involvement and personal statement of intention.

Any application, no matter how outstanding, is automatically eliminated if it is not complete.

Please check application carefully to insure that all required materials and information are included.

#### **Application Procedures**

<u>Academic Scholarships</u>: Application packets can be downloaded from the DHF website: www.durand foundation.com. Click on the blue John Durand Scholarship Program bar on our homepage.

Applications must be postmarked no later than April 15, 2025. If submitted electronically, applications must be time-stamped before 11:59 pm April 15, 2025.

- 2) The awardees will be contacted by letter in May (John's birthday month). Scholarship funds awarded will be sent to successful applicants by July.
- 3) At the end of the academic year, Academic Scholarship Award recipients <u>must</u> provide to the Durand Heritage Foundation Scholarship Committee a brief report on their educational experience for the academic year.

#### Research Awards: Applicants may submit a letter of application at any time that includes:

- 1) A brief description of the proposed research and writing project.
- 2) An explanation of how the project will enrich the Durand family history.
- 3) Proposed time period for the research and writing project.
- 4) The amount of funds requested (up to \$500) and the intended purposes for which the Research Award will be used. Recipient of a Research Award is expected to provide the Durand Heritage Foundation with a written copy of the completed project with the understanding that the results may be published in the DHF newsletter.

#### Application Guidelines for Scholarship Awards 2025-2026 Academic Year Durand Heritage Foundation Scholarship Committee

Scholarship Awards of \$500 will be distributed for the 2025-2026 academic year. Academic Scholarship Awards are made without regard to race, color, religion (creed), gender, gender expression, sexual orientation, national origin (ancestry), disability, marital status, military status or relationship to Durand family to applicants who are currently enrolled in or have been accepted into a post-secondary course of study in an accredited educational program in the United States and Canada. Priority is given to first time applicants. Membership in the Durand Heritage Foundation is not required for eligibility.

- 1) Applicants must submit a **COMPLETE** Scholarship Application.
- 2) Applications must be postmarked no later than April 15, 2025 to be eligible for an award.
- 3) Scholarship Awards will be announced in May, 2025.
- 4) Award checks will be mailed to awardees by July 1, 2025.
- 5) At the end of the 2025-2026 academic year, award recipients <u>must</u> provide a brief summary of the past year's educational experience to the Durand Heritage Foundation Scholarship Committee.
